



Day I: OCT 16 - NEW YORK

Depart for Egypt across the Atlantic and Mediterranean.

Day 2: OCT 17 - CAIRO

The monastery of St. Catherine, the oldest on earth, is where monks have been witnesses to the Christian faith since the fifth century AD. We will view Mt. Sinai where Moses heard the word of God. Continue to Taba for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

DAY 5: OCT 20 - TABA / JERUSALEM


After breakfast we will have a short visit of the beauty of the Red Sea. Go back to the hotel to check out and drive to the border to cross over into Israel and continue Solomon's southern port of Etzion Geber, known today as Eilat on the Red Sea. Continue through the Negev Desert, whose history dates to the tenth century forts constructed by Solomon to defend King David's rule over the Negev. Marvel at the wind carved rock formations known as King Solomon's Pillars. Our motor coach arrives in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

DAY 6: OCT 21 - JERUSALEM

We start the day in the Old City of Jerusalem, visiting St. Anne's Church, the Pool of Bethesda, the Chapel of the Flagellation and the Ecce Homo Arch. We continue through the Bazaar to the Via Dolorosa which winds through the streets of Old Jerusalem commemorating the path that Jesus walked on his way to Calvary. We will carry a wooden cross along this same path ending at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, containing the tomb where Jesus was buried and rose from the dead. Later we head to Bethlehem for an inspiring visit to the Church of the Nativity where Jesus was born, stand on Shepherd's Field and visit the cave where the shepherds saw the star that lead them to the stable. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. (B. D)

DAY 7: OCT 22 - JERUSALEM

Today we participate in a full-day tour of Jerusalem including the Mt. of Olive and Mt. Scopus. Walk down the Palm Sunday Road to the church of Domus Flevits, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem, then continue to the Church of All Nations with the Garden of Gethsemane and pray at the "Rock of Agony." We continue to the Kidron Valley and to Mt. Zion, site of the Upper Room of the Last Supper. We drive to the village of Ein Kerem, to visit the birthplace of St. John the Baptist and to the Church of the Visitation where Mary visited Elizabeth. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. (B, D)



DAY 8: OCT 23 - JERUSALEM

Our destination for today is the Dead Sea region, the lowest point on earth. We drive to Masada, the fortress where Jewish Zealots held off the armies of the Roman Empire before choosing death over surrender. We continue to Ein Gedi, where King David found shelter from the wrath of King Saul. This afternoon we can opt to "float" on the Dead Sea. On our way back to Jerusalem, we visit the caves of Qumran where, in 1947, the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. (B, D)

DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

DAY 9: OCT 24 - GALILEE

Today we travel to Caesarea on the Mediterranean Sea to discover the ancient Crusader and Roman town, its aqueduct and theater. We continue to Mount Carmel we stop at the Carmelite Monastery at the Muhraka, site of Elijah's altar, and Stella Maris Church. Paintings in the church dome depict Old Testament stories, including one of Elijah being swept up to heaven in a fiery chariot. We arrive to our hotel in the Galilee area for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 10: OCT 25 - GALILEE


After early breakfast, our exploration of the Holy Land begins with a cruise on the Sea of Galilee. Continue our visits to Christian sites along the shores of the Sea of Galilee. Jesus taught and performed miracles here. We visit the Mt. of Beatitudes where Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount. The sermon is commemorated in the Church of the Beatitudes, built overlooking the Sea of Galilee. We continue to Tabgha, site of the Miracle of the Loaves and Fishes. A mosaic commemorating this miracle is located near the altar at Tabaha. We also visit Capernaum and the Church of the Primacy of Peter. Time for lunch and the rest of the day at leisure in Tiberias to shop or relax. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.(BD)

DAY 11:OCT 26 - GALILEE / BEN GURION AIRPORT

We start Our morning visiting Nazareth in the Lower Galilee, the place where Jesus grew up and lived most of his life. We visit the Church of the Annunciation, built over the Grotto of the Annunciation, the place where early Christian tradition says that the angel Gabriel spoke to the Blessed Mother. Joseph's carpentry workshop and then to Cana, site of the wedding feast. Later we proceed to the Church of the Transfiguration at Mt. Tabor and the Jordan River, site of Jesus' baptism. Continue to the Old City of Jaffa to enjoy a farewell dinner before being trans-

ferred to the airport for our flight home.(B, D)
